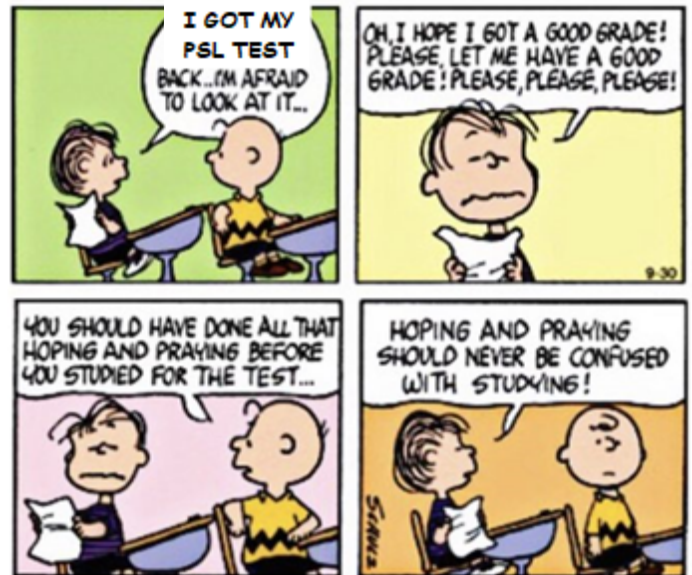


## SERVICE LEARNING 101 EXAM REVIEW

Use this opportunity to prove to your teachers and classmates that you are prepared to represent PSL, PHS, and the community of Perry in whatever service endeavors you participate in this year.



### The exam will consist of 60 questions:

- 14 questions assessing your knowledge of key terms
- 6 questions assessing your knowledge of the PSL survival guide
- 5 questions assessing your knowledge of professional communication guidelines
- 5 questions assessing your knowledge of the Global Goals
- 7 questions assessing your knowledge of different types of experiential learning programs
- 9 questions assessing your knowledge of appropriate/inappropriate volunteer behaviors
- 5 questions assessing your knowledge of professional dress expectations
- 3 questions assessing your knowledge of the InnerView service reflection rubric
- 5 document based questions pertaining to a service-learning article

### Ground rules:

- Desks will be in exam formation when you arrive in PSL.
- You may use your notebook.
- You may NOT use someone else's notes.
- You may NOT use your cell phone.
- You may NOT use your Chromebook/laptop.
- You may NOT use handouts or worksheets.
- Failure to follow ground rules will result in a 0.

**NOTE: All notebooks will be collected on the day of the exam and will be returned to you when ALL students have completed the exam. If you use a multi-subject notebook, you will need to remove your PSL notes so that you will have access to your notebook for other classes.**
