In addition to providing students with a hands-on learning opportunity, these visits empower students to make educated decisions about where to grant their money. The site visit enables students to get to know the organization in a way they just couldn't understand by simply reading the completed grant application. A basic rule every development professional understands is that people give money to people - not programs. The site visit allows students to see where their money is being invested and the people whose lives will be affected by their investment.



What's in it for you?

We understand that conducting a site visit requires a considerable sacrifice of time. In an attempt to compensate students for this sacrifice, any student who conducts a site visit will:



- be treated to lunch <u>or</u> dessert (options include Mama Santa's Pizzeria, Corbo's bakery, Mitchell's Ice Cream, Malley's Ice Cream, etc.)
- be excused from 2 service hours the week that the visit takes place.
- receive 4 hours towards their 10 extra hours
